 - (a) Attorney's report. Attorney James W. Wilson may report on the following district related issues: easements; vendor contracts; inter local governmental agreements and relations; developments and subdivisions; nonstandard service contracts; regulatory compliance issues; district policies and rules; customer disputes; legislation; and matters related to the district's certificate of convenience and necessity and boundaries.
 - (b) Engineer's report. An engineer from Dunaway/DBI, may report on the following district-related issues: standard details, comprehensive planning; future and ongoing water facilities construction projects; storage capacity issues; and other matters as it relates to the district.
 - (c) General Manager's report. Dana Andrews may report on water loss; water system maintenance and status; funding, planning, and construction of new facilities; monthly billing; service accounts; water supply status; updates on residential and commercial developments; easements; customer relations; equipment status and needs; staff policies and general personnel matters; revenues and expenses; and matters as it relates to the district.

 - (a) Discuss and act on a customer currently in arrears of \$1,177.06 that filed bankruptcy on August 4, 2025, and amended the filing to add EFSUD as a creditor on September 11, 2025.
7. New Business.
 - (a) Review and approve a contract for the 500,000-gallon ground storage tank at Ballard St. pump station.

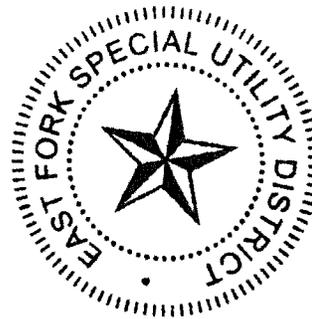
- (b) Discuss and act on Ordinance No. 2025-003, ordering a general election to be held on Saturday, May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing three (3) directors at-large to the Board of Directors of East Fork Special Utility District; appointing an election agent and early voting clerks; providing for Application for a Place on the Ballot; designating the dates, times, and location of early voting and Election Day voting by personal appearance; ordering notices of the election to be given as prescribed by law; appointing a presiding Election Judge and alternate presiding judge; designating the Board Secretary as custodian of voted ballots and election materials for the time provided by law; providing for the conduct of the general election and other matters incident and related to such election; and providing for an effective date.
